

## **Dolgau Project Bulletin Spring 2023**

### **Project Update**

Griffiths started work on the new shared-use footpath between Dole and Bow Street on the 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2023. The initial work consisted of setting up the site compound, installing a temporary boundary fence, topsoil strip and translocation of the existing hedgerow for temporary storage.

Drainage works started in Bow Street on the 27<sup>th</sup> of February. So far 80m of drainage has been installed which will capture water from the A487 highway and new proposed footpath.

A collection of coats has recently been made and donated to the Aber Coats scheme where shops in Aberystwyth provide coat rails; people can collect or donate coats for use by others, free of charge.

During our time on site Jane will engage with local schools to inspire young people into the construction and civil engineering industry through interactive STEM activities and careers sessions. The online resource 'Experience, Educate, Engage,' is available to all schools in Wales on Hwb. One element of the Go Construct Educate programme is the opportunity for schools to invite a speaker from industry to enhance the learning experience bringing the world of work into the classroom. ### **Future Plans**

Following the Easter Holidays work will begin outside the Rhydpennau Inn pub. New drainage kerbs and pre cast concrete kerbs are to be installed, widening the footpath, installation of ducting, earthworks, drainage and surfacing with completion of Section 1 scheduled for completion early May.
