Notice of Abbot Street closure, Wrexham Tuesday 27 August 2024 until early October 2024.

Following our previous correspondence dated August I'm writing to inform you that there is a change to the date that Abbott Street will be closed to all traffic. Due to unforeseen delays, Abbot Street will now be closed from **Tuesday 27 August**.

Access to pedestrians will be maintained, and our staff will be more than happy to assist businesses with goods deliveries, as we have done with businesses along High Street and Town Hill by offering a porter service free of charge. Please speak to one of our staff or contact us via the details at the bottom of this page should you require any assistance.

Work on Town Hill will now be completed on Friday, 23 August, which will see the road fully reopened to traffic. Due to the weekend being a Bank Holiday weekend, the closure of Abbot Street will take place on **Tuesday 27 August** until early October. The closure is necessary so that we can:

- Widen the pavements
- Install new paving and kerbs
- Narrow and resurface the road

Usual working hours will be between 7:30am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 9am until 1pm on Saturday (if required). We will not be working during the August Bank Holiday.

PLEASE NOTE: During the Abbot Street closure, High Street will be accessed from Town Hill, with the current one-way system being reversed so that traffic will be directed up from Town Hill, through High Street towards Yorke Street. The current one-way arrangements on Yorke Street will also be temporarily reversed for traffic to travel between High Street and Eagles Meadow. Access to Charles Street and Chester Street will be maintained, but access will be via Town Hill. Please see map on page 2 of this letter.

During this closure there will be no access to Yorke Street or High Street via Mount Street due to the reversed implemented one way system.

Bin collections on Abbott Street.

We will liaise with you on bin collection days to facilitate those collections. Please contact us using the contact details below if you require any support.

When our works are completed in early October the traffic flow will revert to the current arrangements.

We appreciate that this is a busy area of the City and we apologise in advance for any temporary disruption caused. We will be working as safely, efficiently and to the highest standards possible in order to complete the works as soon as we can. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
