Project Overview

The St Austell to A30 Link Road comprises works to design and construct a new 6.2k single carriageway with climbing lanes from the old A30 at Victoria / Roche to the roundabout at Stenalees. The works also include three new roundabouts, as well as the improvement, rationalisation or relocation of existing access roads that bisect the new alignment and will also carry out environmental mitigation works and maintain the landscape ecology.

Project Update

Finally, we have seen some good weather in the area and this has helped us to make great progress with the project. We have constructed and opened temporary diversion roads on the B3274. This is the only part of the project where the new road will overlap onto the existing carriageway so we have created these temporary diversions to ensure traffic flow in the area.

We currently have Trezaise closed to enable us to complete the brand new junction in the area and get traffic flowing on part of the newly constructed roundabout when this section opens up on the 22nd July. This will allow us to send traffic down the roundabout and to travel through to Whitemoor. We will then close off New Road as a through road to Whitemoor so we can carry out other essential works in the area. This will lead onto our next planned road closure which will be Hensbarrow Hill to complete the tie ins for the new arm of the roundabout that will lead onto this road. You would have seen a new junction situated on New Road with a turning that is currently incomplete. We will be building a new road leading up to Hensbarrow Hill towards Greensplat that HGVs and vehicles can use to access this area.

We will have further works in the Stenalees area but this will be in September/ October and will update in the next newsletter.
