Project Overview

The St Austell to A30 Link Road comprises works to design and construct a new 6.2k single carriageway with climbing lanes from the old A30 at Victoria / Roche to the roundabout at Stenalees. The works also include three new roundabouts, as well as the improvement, rationalisation or relocation of existing access roads that bisect the new alignment and will also carry out environmental mitigation works and maintain the landscape ecology.

Trezaise Road Closure

Griffiths will have to close this section of road from 11TH June for six weeks. We understand the frustration this will cause but due to the nature of the works which consists of changing the existing road layout and a new junction and kerb linings being installed it is not possible to carry this out under traffic lights. Our website is updated with more information about this closure and the current diversion drawings and where the closure will be so people can look at these in more detail. Bus Update

The works at Higher Trezaise will see changes to the no. 26 bus service and arrangements for buses to Brannel School.

Plans are being put in place to maintain service 26 in Roche following the normal route from St Austell through Penwithick and Bugle as far as Higher Trezaise where buses will then operate via Cleers and Harmony Road. Subject to confirmation of a suitable turning place buses will travel through the village to the Sport Club before continuing on the normal route to Bodmin. Buses towards St Austell will operate the reverse of this route.

Specific arrangements for Brannel School pupils who use the BRA-020 and BRA-021 services will be sent to parents by the Transport Co-ordination Service.

Stannary Road-Stenalees- 3rd- 14th June 2024

Two way lights to complete south entrance tie in to Roche Road access road.

Singlerose Roundabout- Stenalees- 16th September- 4th October 2024.

Four-way lights on the roundabout to complete remedial work needed on the A391.
