Project Overview

The St Austell to A30 Link Road comprises works to design and construct a new 6.2k single carriageway with climbing lanes from the old A30 at Victoria / Roche to the roundabout at Stenalees. The works also include three new roundabouts, as well as the improvement, rationalisation or relocation of existing access roads that bisect the new alignment and will also carry out environmental mitigation works and maintain the landscape ecology.

Project Update

There will be some changes on the B3274 between Roche and Stenalees in the New Year whilst we finish off the remaining tie ins and restructuring of the road for the final part of the project. This work is needed to complete the road and join it all up together ready to be open and complete.

Letters and diversion routes will be sent out with this information over the next few weeks.

Visually when driving through you will see we are making great progress, and we are on track for the whole road to open February/March time 2025. Majority of drainage works have now been completed across the whole road and we have managed to start surfacing in areas between Stenalees and Roche. Unfortunately, this time of year weather will impact our works, but we are hopeful we can still stay on programme.

We have six weekly drone footage taken and these are uploaded to our community website page under project videos for people to have a look at our progress, particularly in areas that cannot be seen from driving through. Link to the website can be found on the next page.
